Dear friends,

Thank all of you who attended the Parish meeting. We cannot thank Chuck Lee, Jacqueline Hoover, Ed Colucci and Bo Chamberlain enough for all the work they have accomplished for this parish in the past three years. We have come through some hard years. Perseverance has brought us to a new day. We welcome the leadership of five new Vestry persons: Julie Novak, Rick Mathis, Linda Palacio, Scott Steele and Jennifer Norred. How gifted we are to have such leadership!

Our year end report is strong---the parish finished the year in the black, and we continued to grow. Please remember the parish during the summer---our bills do not take a vacation. Please attempt to remain current on your pledges---it is easy to forget when we are out of town.

Because we are not at full enrollment in our School, and we have given five times the financial aid we did in 2007 this past year, we have not been able to reduce our indebtedness as rapidly as we had projected. Thanks to great work by the school's treasurer Bill Winchester, we have been able to move our loans out from 2014 to 2016 before we have to refinance again. Still, we need more scholarship aid, and this can be provided by reducing our debt.

Many churches have endowed their way out of debt, and we can do the same. I have put St Peter's in my will---it is easy and saves taxes. One can even name the church as a beneficiary to a life insurance policy and the premiums are deductible. There are annuities that can be purchased through the National Church that pay you a fixed income and then are donated to the church. If you have questions, call the church.

Not that I complain of want. For I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content, I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound; in any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and want. I can do all things in him who strengthens me". (Phil 4: 11-13)

## VORP Ministry

The **Victim Offender Reconciliation Program (VORP)** is a voluntary process in which a juvenile offender (under 18 y/o) who has committed a nonviolent crime, such as shoplifting or vandalism, meets with the victim of the crime in the presence of a trained volunteer facilitator. The meeting serves to "set things right" between the offender and the victim. Upon successful completion of this program and restitution by the offender, the offending youth's police record is expunged if no other offenses occur before the youth's 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.

I think of this ministry as a second chance for the offending young people. Their ability to make good decisions is still forming and consequences of these decisions are not factored into decision making. Peer pressure is often an issue for youths who have not learned that "No" is sometimes the best decision. VORP enables offending youths to realize that someone has been harmed by their actions and allows them to apologize and make restitution to the victim. The victim has the opportunity to meet and talk with the offender about the crime. In this process, youths learn about accountability for their actions.

The biggest pluses for me in this ministry are helping our community's youths learn how to make better choices in their lives and their getting a second chance (no record) for their future. Offending youths are 8 times less likely to re-offend after going through this program.

Carter Paden called the meeting to order, and Jacqueline Hoover, Parish Clerk, recorded minutes. The Clerk recorded the following Vestry members being present at the meeting, representing a quorum of the Vestry: Ed Colucci, David Dalton, Jacqueline Hoover, Chuck Lee, Telky Murphy, Barbara Painter, Frank Pinchak, and Chip Stansbury and Ruth Wilson. Bo Chamberlain, Robert Hartmans and Beth Janney were not present.

The Parish Clerk announced that the minutes for the Regular Vestry meeting held The minutes were approved. (David Dalton moved and Chuck Lee seconded).

After review and discussion, the Treasurer's Reports, ending March 31, 2011, were tabled again, waiting clarification.

The Treasurer's Report entitled, "Net Cash Flow", dated April 1 to April 30, 2011 was approved. (Chuck Lee moved Barbara Painter seconded).

- Discussion continued regarding our annual parish meeting to be held on May 22, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. All vestry members are asked to attend the annual meeting.

- Vestry nominations were discussed. Call assignments were given to vestry members to call and report back to Frank Pinchak. Leaving the Vestry will be Bo Chamberlain, Ed Colucci, Jacqueline Hoover and Chuck Lee. Robert Hartmans partial term will also be filled.

Election ballots are to be completed by the parish clerk.

#### School Update

After introduction and discussion, and upon motion duly made and carried by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Vestry in attendance at the meeting, the Vestry adopted the following resolution:

- Move to accept the nomination for four individuals to replace members of the school board that are rotating off the board. The nominees are: Morgan Everett, Mario Haynie, Kymberly Restelli and Cynthia Mitchell. Their term starts June 2011 and will be for two (2) years. (Chuck Lee moved and Frank Pinchak seconded). Chuck Lee reported School numbers continue to do well.

#### Bank Loans for School (Refinance)

Work continues on refinancing long term debt for the school. Two options are: extending loans from First Tennessee Bank, and securing funds from the Opportunity Fund of the Diocese of East Tennessee. Paperwork has been completed and submitted for the Opportunity Fund from the Diocese of East Tennessee.

#### Duplex Update

David Dalton reported remodeling (painting, flooring, replacing light fixtures and etc.) was being done on one half of the duplex. Attempts are being made to secure some used appliances to replace the existing ones.

### Kindergarten students end a busy school year

Kindergarten students have had a busy spring with several year-end projects and their annual play. This year's original play, "**Rainforest/Jungle Rumble**," played off of the **Core Knowledge** habitats, animals and geography they recently learned. The play featured songs such as "**Little Green Frog**," "**Three Little Monkeys**," and "**Conga Line**." The finale "**Circle of Life**" from **Lion King** emphasized the importance of conservation and saving the earth and its creatures.

Shortly after their play, **Ms. Mabry and Ms. Lisa's** kindergarten students "flew" to **Australia** with their "passports." The **Air Mabry pilot** gave an overview of the country. Students learned about some of the animals and talked about new vocabulary words. When they "landed," their passports were stamped by Ms. Dana and the children were allowed to enter the country for a few weeks.

Recently, kindergarteners delved into art with a special study of **Eric Carle**. After watching a video showing how author/artist **Eric Carle** creates his books, the Kindergarten classes decided to try their hand at creating pictures from several **Eric Carle** books. Each student chose his or her favorite animal from books such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Grouchy Ladybug, and Dragons, Dragons. The technique involved layering colored tissue paper onto construction paper, then cutting out shapes to create their own unique design. Check out their beautiful, colorful creations on the first floor of Carson Hall by the staircase.

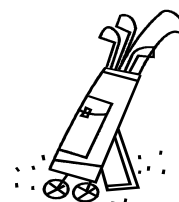

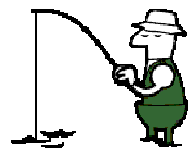
